We want to thank Linda for all of her years of service tending to the school house. I would also like to thank ALL of our Board Members and Officers who work behind the scenes tending the garden, checking on the school house, creating and maintaining the website, readying the school for Open House, and training the parents to step in as schoolmarms and schoolmasters.
